Dear Parents and Community Members:

We are pleased to present you with the Annual Education Report (AER) which provides key information on the 2014-15 educational progress for the Watervliet Middle School. The AER addresses the complex reporting information required by federal and state laws. The school's report contains information about student assessment, accountability, and teacher quality. If you have any questions about the AER, please contact Dave Armstrong for assistance.

Watervliet Middle School students scored well on the Reading and Writing portion of the MSTEP test during the 2014-2015 school year. Student test scores were above state average in each grade. We believe this is due to our implementation of reading intervention classes and also the additional reading that has been added to class time. A challenge for Watervliet Middle School is the math scores from the math test associated with the MSTEP. Math scores were low compared to the state test scores. We have implemented math intervention classes throughout the day. We also have an after school math program which has been offered to each student. Currently the after school math class has an enrollment of over twenty students. We are looking for ways to have additional students join the class. The MSTEP science and social studies tests are also a challenge to WMS. We have implemented more writing and graph work for student improvement in each area.

State law requires that we also report additional information:

1. **School Assignment:** All students in the Watervliet District in grade 6-8 are assigned to Watervliet Middle School because there is no other school available.
2. **School Improvement Plan:** Teachers have a curriculum map aligned with Michigan Core State Standards for ELA and Math. Social studies and science are aligned with the Michigan Grade Level Standards and Benchmarks. With the curriculum map alignment teachers spend PLC time meeting to discuss the WMS School Improvement Plan.

Current goals for the SI plan include:

- a. Create and maintain a district-wide system of databased decision making.
- b. All students will meet the College/Career Readiness standards in MATH as evidenced by ACT Explore achievement.

- c. Literacy - All students at Watervliet Middle School will meet the College/Career Readiness standards in Literacy as evidenced by ACT/Explore achievement by 8/31/2016
 - d. All students at Watervliet Middle School will become technologically literate
3. **Special Education:** Watervliet Middle School served 30 students in special education and 14 students in speech during the 2014-2015 school year. To meet individual needs, some students need educational programs the district cannot provide. In cooperation with Berrien Regional Educational Service Agency (BRESA) and certain neighboring districts, these students attend appropriate Special Education programs in other locations. The programs available to Watervliet students were:
- Early Childhood Developmentally Delayed Program; located at Coloma Elementary and facilitated by Coloma Community Schools
 - Hearing Impaired Program; located at Berrien Springs Public Schools and facilitated by Berrien RESA
 - Cognitively Impaired Program; located at Berrien Springs Middle School and facilitated by Berrien Springs Public Schools
 - Moderately to Severely Mentally Impaired Program; located at Blossomland Learning Center, Berrien Springs and facilitated by Berrien RESA
 - Early Childhood Developmentally Delayed and Autistic Impaired Program; located at Stewart Elementary and facilitated by Lakeshore Public Schools
 - Severely Emotionally Impaired and Autistic Impaired Program; located at Lighthouse Learning Center, St. Joseph, and facilitated by Berrien RESA
 - Severely Emotionally Impaired Program; located at Niles Southside and facilitated by Niles Community Schools
4. **Academic Instruction Program:** Watervliet Middle School's program of academic instruction incorporates the Michigan Grade Level Standards and Benchmarks for science and social studies and the Michigan Core State Standards for ELA and Math. Information on our core curriculum can be obtained by contacting the school office. The materials we use are Glencoe Literature for Language Arts instruction, math text book is BIG IDEAS MATH, publisher Big Ideas Learning LLC , *Battle Creek Science Kits* for science instruction in 6th and 7th, Pearson Interactive Science in 8th and Prentice Hall's World Explorer in social studies instruction. More detailed information is available on the Watevliet Middle School tab on the district website.
5. **Test Results:** 8th grade student test scores for 2015: ELA 52% proficient, Math Social Studies 25% proficient. 7th grade student test scores: ELA 60% proficient, Math 26% proficient, Science 15% proficient. 6th grade student test scores: ELA 44% proficient, Math 26% proficient
6. **Parent Contacts:** Parents are provided with opportunities to hold conferences with teachers to discuss individual students' progress, academic strengths and any areas of concern. Occasionally, phone calls take the place of face-to-face conferences. We have

fall and spring conferences scheduled each school year. Parents were informed of conferences through school handbooks and newsletters. WMS parents were also scheduled for specific times through phone calls, letters or email. The percentage of parents who attend conferences with teachers in 2013-2014 was 75%; participation for 2014-2015 was 71%. WMS also offers the Parent Internet Grade Book so parents can view grades and homework assignments daily. Teachers and parents can post questions or comments concerning each individual student.

Watervliet Middle School students and staff are committed to student learning. We are working together to encourage and motivate students to increase their knowledge in each subject. Through hard work and dedication by the staff and students we are hoping to see significant increases in student MSTEP scores. The addition of intervention classes, after school math enhancement classes, and Summer School Academy will help to assist students in gaining knowledge that will be used throughout their high school and college careers.
