Dear Parents and Community Members:

We are pleased to present you with the Annual Education Report (AER) which provides key information on the 2013-2014 educational progress for Watervliet High School. The AER addresses the complex reporting information required by federal and state laws. The school's report contains information about student assessment, Adequate Yearly Progress (AYP) and teacher quality. The state has identified some schools with the status of Reward, Focus or Priority. A reward school is one that is outperforming other schools in achievement, growth, or is performing better than other schools with a similar student population. A Focus school is one that has a large achievement gap in 30% of its student achievement scores. A priority school is one whose achievement and growth is in the lowest 5% of all schools in the state.

Our school HAS NOT been given one of these labels.

While we are pleased with our recent achievements, we are continuously working to improve. We appreciate the continued support of parents, staff and our community in this effort and we will continue working diligently moving forward. We have implemented multiple intervention based initiatives in order to take our student achievement to the next level and we are excited about where we are going.

ASSIGNING PUPILS TO THE SCHOOL

Students are assigned to Watervliet High School by grade level and credits earned. Based on how many credits a student has earned, determines what grade level they will participate in.

SCHOOL IMPROVEMENT PLAN

Watervliet High School has spent the last three years implementing, adjusting and working on a new school improvement plan. We will continue to let our SIP guide our professional development for the upcoming school year.

SPECIALIZED SCHOOL OPPORTUNITIES

Along with our regular education services provided through our high school, we are pleased to be able to provide additional services:

- Berrien RESA provides services to special needs students through Blossomland Learning Center, Lighthouse Education Center, and the Berrien County Hearing Impaired Program.
- Furthermore, Berrien RESA works in conjunction with the Berrien County Juvenile Detention Center to provide services to students being housed at the center.
- During this past school year we had over sixty-three (63) students attend the Van Burien Intermediate School District for vocational education classes.

CORE CURRICULUM

Watervliet High School does not vary from the state's model. A copy of the current Michigan High School Content Expectations for all core areas is available from the Michigan Department of Education website at: www.mich.gov/mde. Furthermore, a copy can be viewed in Mr. Ledlow's office at Watervliet High School.

MME RESULTS

Watervliet High School eligible juniors take the Michigan Merit Exam in early March each school year. This data can be viewed in the Annual Education Report, which is available online at <http://www.watervlietps.org>. If you are unable to access the information via the internet, copies can be viewed in Mr. Ledlow's office.

PARENT/TEACHER CONFERENCES

Watervliet High School offers parent-teacher conferences in the November and February of each school year. Between the two conference times our students were represented by 20% their parents. We also provide a parent internet viewer, which allows parents to view their child's progress in each of their classes. In addition to report cards four times a year, progress reports are also mailed out every three weeks.

Postsecondary enrollments

Last school year, Watervliet High School had forty-one (41) students enrolled in postsecondary classes for a total of 10.85% of the student body.

College Equivalent courses offered

Last school year Watervliet High School offered AP Calculus, AP Biology, College English, and this year we will be offering AP European History. We also offer a plethora of college equivalent courses through Michigan Virtual High School.

Students enrolled in college equivalent courses

Last school year Watervliet High School had forty-eight (54) students enrolled in college equivalent courses for a total of 14.2%

Students receiving a score leading to college credit

Last year Watervliet High School had forty-eight (48) students receive college credit for a total of 12.6%.

I am overjoyed with the successes of our students during the 2013-2014 school year. This would not have been possible without the combined effort put forth between the staff and parents.
